

In 2025, the *From the Land of Kansas* program fulfilled a total of 148 benefits serving its members, which is a 14% increase from last year. These benefits included support to increase product sales and business marketing, as well as the creation of barcodes that helped businesses expand into additional retail outlets. The program's goal is to support and serve Kansas-based businesses that grow, raise, produce, or process products in the state by adapting to their individual needs and providing tailored resources and marketing opportunities.

The *From the Land of Kansas* e-commerce site generated \$49,674.10 in sales during 2025. The site allows program members to sell products online without the burden of managing their own e-commerce platforms, giving businesses additional sales opportunities while allowing them to focus on other aspects of their operations. The site also serves as a one-stop shop for consumers seeking Kansas-made products. The platform had products from 21 members, with items ranging from food items such as sunflower oil, jellies, dip mixes, barbecue sauces, and beef jerky to nonfood items, including wheat art, soaps, lavender products, pet treats, and more.



Social Media

This benefit provides members with opportunities to strengthen their social media presence through support and promotional features. Being highlighted as a Social Media Member of the Month allows a business to gain exposure through curated content shared on Facebook and Instagram. Members may also participate in on-site visits, which create opportunities for video production or Facebook Live events. The Kansas Value Added Foods Lab offers a wide array of services to Kansas businesses, including food product development, processes, nutrition facts panel, and ingredients listing.

Product Photography

One of the new benefits added was Product Photography. This benefit is intended to give members clear, high-quality photos of their products that are then easily used on their websites or promotional materials. In 2025, the program edited roughly 130 photos for members to utilize on their e-commerce websites or other platforms of their choice. Barcodes

Barcodes, or UPCs, are a required step toward selling products in many retail outlets. The program purchases barcodes in bulk and offers them to members at a significant discount to help decrease the barriers for entry into retail. A total of 32 businesses utilized the UPC Barcode program in 2025.


KANSAS HOLIDAY GIFT BOXES

Holiday Gift Boxes

From the Land of Kansas celebrated its ninth year of the Kansas Holiday Gift Box program. The program featured 12 members from across the state, highlighting a wide variety of Kansas-made goods that offer diverse and flavorful selections. The Kansas Holiday Boxes were sold online at Shop.FromtheLandofKansas.com. Both the Ad Astra and Konza Holiday Gift Boxes featured unique products from local producers, ranging from seasoning, sauces, and mixes to sweet treats and savory snacks. In 2025, the Holiday Boxes had more reach than last year, making it to 46 different states with Kansas being the leading state followed by Texas and California. Nearly 700 boxes were sold this year. Each box reflected the mission of *From the Land of Kansas* by celebrating and supporting agricultural products that are grown, raised and produced locally.

OUTREACH & EVENTS

Throughout the year, the program participated in several key events, including the Farm to School Heartland Institute, Coffee and Conversations, the Women Managing the Farm Conference, the Kansas Farm Bureau Annual Meeting, Kansas Association of Conservation District's Annual Convention, and the Regional Farm to School Summit. These events provided valuable opportunities to engage with stakeholders, share resources, and strengthen partnerships across Kansas agriculture.

From the Land of Kansas promoted local Kansas farms and businesses through a wide range of media outlets, including Kansas Country Living, WIBW, social media platforms, and local newspapers.

In addition, the team traveled extensively across the state visiting members in communities such as Liberal, Burdett, Beloit, Salina, Pittsburg, Wichita, Council Grove, Bronson, Lawrence, Olathe, and Parsons, among others. During these travels, the team focused on building strong relationships, highlighting member stories, and strengthening connections within Kansas agriculture.

The program's goal is to help each business grow in a manner tailored to their individual needs to give them resources and support. This support may



include supplying additional *From the Land of Kansas* stickers to help identify products as Kansas-made, assisting with barcoding or labeling to expand in-store opportunities, or providing online marketing support for members who may not have the time or resources to do so themselves. In each case, the goal is to help members grow and succeed.

As Ray Rome of Hoganville Family Farms shared, "They just sell better when they have that sticker on them." This statement captures the impact of the program. *From the Land of Kansas* makes it easier for consumers to find and support Kansas-made products and Kansas-based businesses through the recognition and trust associated with the program's trademark logo.

AG DAY AT THE CAPITOL

In honor of Kansas Agriculture Day, the *From the Land of Kansas* program spent the day at the Capitol. 14 members participated to sample and share about their products.



OUTREACH & EVENTS

Cheers Kansas Wine Festival

The Cheers Kansas Wine Festival was held on May 10 in Wamego and showcased Kansas wines, local food products, and live music. *From the Land of Kansas* members Cocoavino, MKC Kitchen, Just Nuts, Prairy, Brunkow Family Lamb, and King Bee participated in sampling food products. The *From the Land of Kansas* team supported the event through marketing, set-up, check-in, and tear-down. This event provided an opportunity to support the Kansas wine industry while promoting local food producers and strengthening partnerships across the state.



Flint Hills Feast

Flint Hills Feast highlighted *From the Land of Kansas* members Alma Bakery, Alma Cheese, Boot Hill Distillery, Brunkow Family Lamb, Grandma Hoerner's, Flint Hills Pints, MKC Kitchen, SHoney Farm, The Sweet Granada, and Tallgrass Tap House. The *From the Land of Kansas* team sponsored and participated in the event with a booth promoting the program and its members.



Kansas Holiday Market

On Small Business Saturday, the *From the Land of Kansas* program and the Flint Hills Discovery Center partnered to embrace the spirit of the holiday season and create a unique outdoor shopping experience dedicated to Kansas products. Bringing a variety of businesses together in one place created a successful space that gave shoppers the opportunity to explore many products from around the area.

OUTREACH & EVENTS

Local Food Producer Workshops

The Kansas Department of Agriculture, in partnership with K-State Extension, offered six regional Local Food Producer Workshops across the state to support farmers' market vendors and managers, as well as individuals interested in selling food products directly to consumers. The *From the Land of Kansas* team played an active role in planning and presenting at the workshops and attended each event to educate producers and answer questions. Workshop topics included food safety, marketing strategies, regulations for selling meat, eggs, and poultry, sales tax requirements for vendors, and Kansas Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program training. The KDA Weights and Measures

Program offered free scale certification for workshop attendees.

In addition, the *From the Land of Kansas* team hosted three webinars specifically focusing on serving market managers in the month of April. Kansas farmers' markets not only provide access to fresh, local food but also stimulate the local economy. In 2025, more than 100 farmers' markets were registered with the KDA's Central Registration of Farmers' Markets housed in the *From the Land of Kansas* program, including nine new markets.



Farmers' Markets

August was declared as Kansas Farmers' Market Month and our *From the Land of Kansas* team and a few markets from across the state joined Governor Kelly in a proclamation signing. *From the Land of Kansas* is proud to support markets by providing the central registration for markets and the program helps consumers support local producers and the local economy.

Coffee and Conversations and Member Meet Ups

The *From the Land of Kansas* team joined the Ag Business Development team on the road this year, participating in seven Coffee and Conversations events and conducting member visits across the state. The first member meet-up was held in Salina, and featured Bushton Manufacturing, Sustain-A-Grain, Papa Baldy's Popcorn, and Helmuth Country Bakery. The program also traveled the state visiting members like 156 Stop-N-Go, Wild Ivy Herb Farm, and Hat Creek Butchery.
